Located on the northeastern side of the park, this zone is famous for its hilly terrain, river streams, and dense forests. Known as a paradise for bird lovers and seasoned safari-goers, it offers a raw, offbeat jungle experience away from the busier zones.

Why Visit Durga Devi Zone?

- **Wild & Rugged Beauty:** Rolling hills, river streams, and dense vegetation.
 - **Rare Sightings:** Known for leopards, elephants, and wild boars.
 - **Birdwatcher's Heaven:** Spot unique species like the grey-headed fish eagle, crested laughing thrush, and long-tailed broadbill.
 - **Peaceful Experience:** Less commercialized, ideal for explorers who prefer untouched wilderness.
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Safari Options in Durga Devi Zone

Jeep Safari

- The only safari option available in this zone.
 - Maximum **6 people per jeep**.
 - Best suited for birdwatchers, photographers, and those seeking a raw, authentic experience.

- **Morning Safari:** 6:00 AM – 9:30 AM
 - **Afternoon Safari:** 2:00 PM – 5:30 PM
(Timings may vary seasonally.)
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Wildlife Highlights in Durga Devi

- **Leopards:** The zone is particularly known for leopard sightings.
 - **Elephants & Deer:** Herds of elephants, sambar deer, and spotted deer roam freely.
 - **Wild Boars & Otters:** Common along the riverbanks.
 - **Birds:** One of the best zones for birdwatching—species like the maroon oriole, barbet, and forktails are often seen.
 - **Mahseer Fish:** The Ramganga and Mandal rivers in the zone are famous for this prized species.
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Scenic Attractions in Durga Devi

- **Ramganga River & Mandal River:** Flowing through the zone, attracting both animals and birds.
 - **Hilly Landscape:** Offers breathtaking views and a different terrain from other Corbett zones.
 - **Dense Forest Trails:** Rich in sal, bamboo, and mixed vegetation.
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Important Guidelines

- Safaris require **government-issued permits**.
- Limited permits per day – book in advance.
- Carry **valid photo ID** for entry.
- Entry/Exit through **Durga Devi Gate**.



- Follow all national park rules: no stepping out of jeeps, no feeding animals, no plastic waste.
