Why Visit Phato & Pakhro Zones?

- New & Undisturbed: These zones are relatively less explored, ensuring peaceful safaris.
- **High Tiger Activity:** Known for frequent tiger movement and fresh pugmarks.
- Rich Flora & Fauna: Dense sal forests, riverbeds, and hilly terrains.
- Wild Elephants & Leopards: Both zones are famous for elephant herds and leopard sightings.
- **Birdwatcher's Delight:** Spot hornbills, kingfishers, eagles, and other exotic birds.

Morning Safari: 6:00 AM - 9:30 AM

 Afternoon Safari: 2:00 PM – 5:30 PM (Timings may vary seasonally.)

Wildlife Highlights

- **Tigers:** Frequent pugmarks and sightings reported.
- **Leopards:** Excellent chances to spot this elusive predator.
- Wild Elephants: Large herds often cross paths during safaris.
- **Deer Species:** Spotted deer, sambar deer, and barking deer are commonly seen.
- **Birds:** Ideal for bird photography hornbills, parakeets, barbets, and more.
- **Reptiles & Lesser-known Species:** Monitor lizards, jackals, and porcupines also call these zones home.

Scenic Attractions

- **Dense Sal Forests:** Pure jungle vibes with thick greenery.
- Rugged Trails: Perfect for those who enjoy adventurous rides.
- Water Streams: Seasonal streams attract animals and birds.

Important Guidelines

- Entry is only with pre-booked government permits. Limited jeeps per day – early booking is essential.
- Carry valid photo ID proof at the time of safari.
- Entry through Phato Gate (near Ramnagar) or Pakhro Gate (near Kotdwar) depending on the zone.



 Follow Corbett's eco-guidelines: no littering, no loud noise, no stepping out of jeeps.
